Brown County Landfill director receives recognition

Mike Scott, Brown County Landfill director, received an award Tuesday from Robert Roberts, Region 8 administrator for the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency. The award was for leadership and environmental achievement in solid waste management.



It was presented during the weekly Brown County Commission meeting.

"It's a first-class, premier facility and serves as a model for other facilities," Roberts said, describing the Brown County Landfill.

"It's no surprise to us that (the landfill) got it," said commissioner Tom Fischbach.

A release stated that when it comes to the landfill, the customer comes first. Landfill employees work to make it easy for customers to drop off refuse, whether it be individual drop-off sites or the marked-off spaces for individual refuse at the landfill.

"The workers are the ones that do it," Scott said, referring to how the award was won.

"It's a good example for the whole state," said commissioner Dennis Feickert.
